

Qualification Results Analysis

The 2024-2025 Year 11 cohort consisted of 15 learners.

Maths: 73% of learners were entered for GCSE Maths; 9% achieved a Grade 1, 27% achieved a Grade 2, 18% achieved a Grade 3, 36% achieved a Grade 4 and 9% achieved a Grade 5. 100% of learners completed the Functional Skills Level 1 qualification; 80% achieved a pass. 100% of learners were also entered for Entry Level Maths; 73% of these achieved an Entry Level 3, 20% achieved Entry Level 2 and 7% achieved Entry Level 1.

English: 20% of learners were entered for GCSE English; 66% achieved a Grade 3 and 33% achieved a Grade 2. 93% of learners completed the Entry Level Step Up to English qualification; 72% achieved an Entry Level 3, 14% achieved Entry Level 2 and 14% achieved Entry Level 1.

Science: 33% of learners were entered for GCSE Chemistry; 20% achieved a Grade 2, 40% achieved a Grade 3 and 40% a Grade 5. 100% of learners completed the Entry Level Certificate; 40% achieved an Entry Level 3, 30% achieved an Entry Level 2 and 30% achieved an Entry Level 1

Art: 20% of learners were entered for GCSE Art; 33% achieved a Grade 2, 33% achieved a Grade 3 and 33% achieved a Grade 4.

Computing: 33% of learners were entered for Entry Level Computer Science; 80% achieved an Entry Level 2 and 20% achieved an Entry Level 3.

Vocational (Food and Cookery, Music Technology, Creative iMedia, Health and Fitness, Expressive Arts):

93% of learners accessed some form of vocational qualification. 71% of these learners completed 2 vocational courses. Of this cohort, 36% of learners passed both of their qualifications. 29% of learners completed 1 vocational course. 100% of these learners passed this qualification.
