

Qualification Results Analysis

The 2025-2026 Year 11 cohort consisted of 17 learners.

Maths: 10 learners were entered for GCSE Maths; 20% achieved a Grade 1, 40% achieved a Grade 2, 10% achieved a Grade 3, 10% achieved a Grade 4 and 20% achieved a Grade 5. 13 learners completed the Functional Skills qualification; 38% achieved a pass. All learners were also entered for Entry Level Maths; 76% of these achieved an Entry Level 3 and 24% achieved Entry Level 2.

English: 5 learners were entered for GCSE English; 1 learner achieved a Grade 8. 40% achieved a Grade 5, 20% achieved a Grade 3 and 20% achieved a Grade 2. 88% of learners were entered for the Entry Level Step Up to English qualification; 87% achieved an Entry Level 3.

Science: 6 learners were entered for Combined Science GCSE; 100% of learners achieved a Grade 2 or above. 67% of learners achieved at least one Grade 5. 94% of learners completed the Entry Level Certificate; 38% achieved an Entry Level 3, 31% achieved an Entry Level 2 and 31% achieved an Entry Level 1.

Art: 24% of learners were entered for GCSE Art; 75% achieved a Grade 3 and 25% achieved a Grade 4.

Computing: 35% of learners were entered for Entry Level Computer Science; 33% achieved an Entry Level 2 and 67% achieved an Entry Level 3.

Vocational (Food and Cookery, Music Technology, Creative iMedia, Health and Fitness):

82% of learners accessed some form of vocational qualification. 14% of these learners completed 2 vocational courses, with 100% achievement. For the rest of the cohort, 58% passed their qualification.
