



GCSE RESULTS AND CERTIFICATES!

All Year 11 pupils are invited into school to collect their results slips
on **Thursday 22nd August** between **10am and 11am**.

Due to the big move happening over the summer to our new school, we will be setting up a temporary office at Discovery. We are therefore asking pupils to meet us at Discovery: Vernons Lane, Nuneaton, CV11 5SS. If you are unable to attend, we will ring you with your results and slips will be posted home by 1st class mail.

As we approach GCSE results day, I'd like to make you aware of the new grading system. GCSEs in England were reformed in 2017. The new reformed GCSEs have a 9 to 1 grading system to better differentiate between the highest performing students and distinguish clearly between the old and new qualifications. The new GCSE grading scale is not directly equivalent to the old A* to G one however, there are some comparable points between the old grades and the new ones, as the diagram shows. The bottom of grade 7 is aligned with the bottom of grade A. The bottom of grade 4 is aligned with the bottom of grade C and the bottom of grade 1 is aligned with the bottom of grade G.
