Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to let you know that there has been a significant rise in the number of COVID 19 across Warwickshire which has resulted in some schools having to use their contingency plans again.

We are working with the current Government guidance so staff are asked to isolate from work, for at least five days, should they test positive for Covid-19.

We will continue to make any decision **on a daily basis** and will communicate any decision made through, e-mail and text. I would also like to take this opportunity to remind you that school attendance is mandatory. However, if your child is required to stay at home as a result of our contingency plan it **will not go against** their attendance figures as these are exceptional circumstances.
