Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to let you know that there has been a significant rise in the number of COVID 19 across Warwickshire which has resulted in some schools having to use their contingency plans again.

We are working with the current Government guidance so staff are asked to isolate from work, for at least five days, should they test positive for Covid-19.

Below is a summary of the dates your child may be asked to study from home:

We will continue to make any decision on a daily basis and will communicate any decision made through, e-mail and text. Where possible we will try to contact you by phone. It would be very helpful if you could contact the taxi providers to let them know of our decision due to the time it may take to phone all families.

I would also like to take this opportunity to remind you that school attendance is mandatory. However, if your child is required to stay at home as a result of our contingency plan it **will not go against** their attendance figures as these are exceptional circumstances.
