- Staff are here to help.



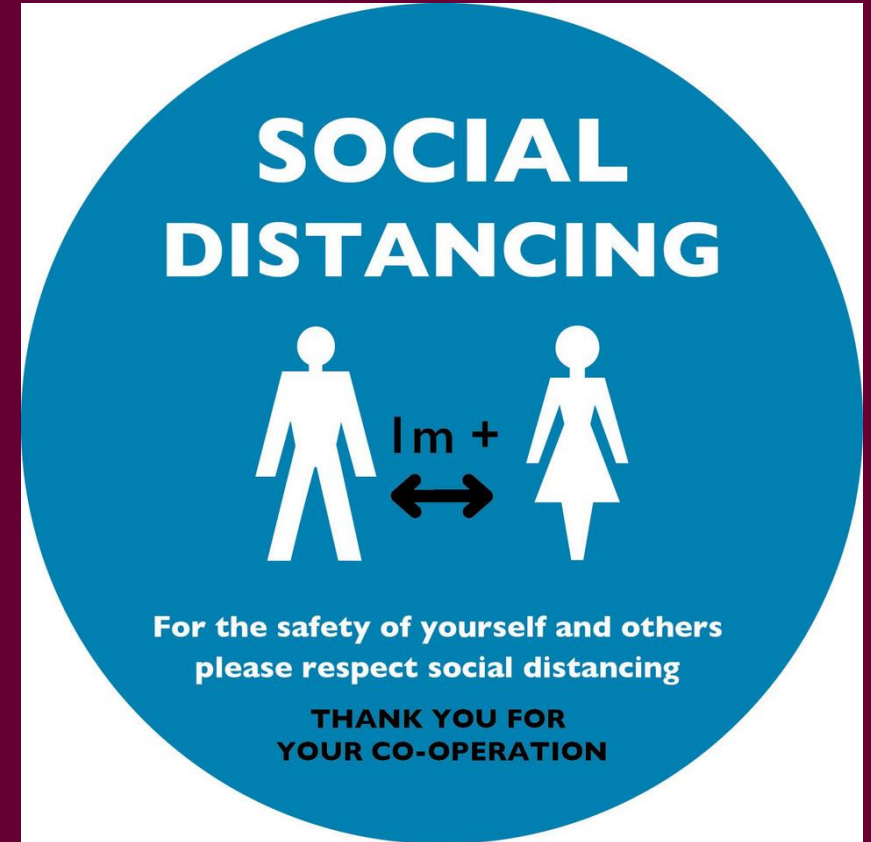
COVID-19

- The recommended distance apart from other people is at least 1 metres.

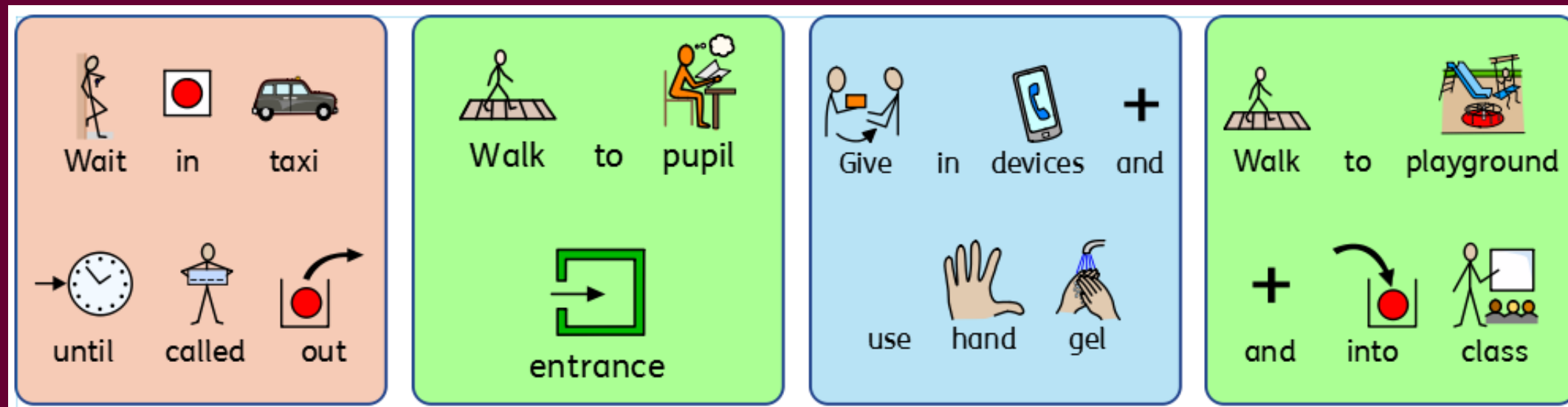


Washing hands



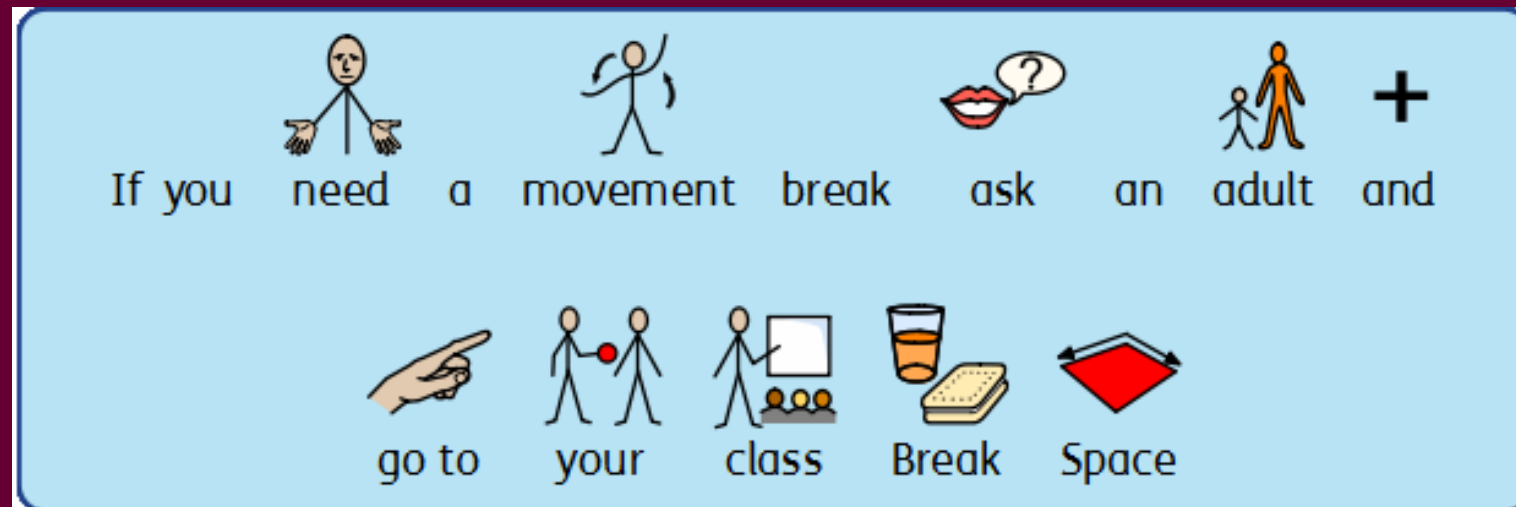
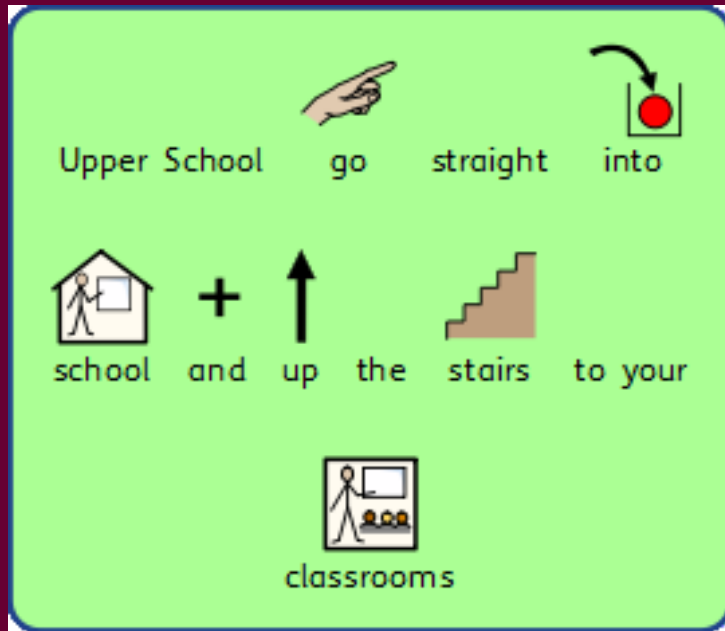
- ▶ Washing your hands helps stop the spread of the virus.
- ▶ Everyone must wash their hands:
 - Before eating
 - Before cooking
 - After going to the toilet
 - After coughing or sneezing
 - Before and After going to out to Play
 - Before and After using specialist equipment
- ▶ Adults may tell you to wash your hands at other times. This is okay.

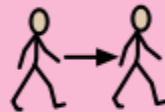
Toilets and Corridors



Your class will have its own Toilet



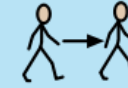
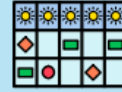
Downstairs we will follow the arrows to move around school

They will be cleaned before and after you use them.

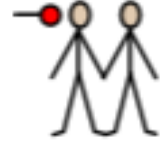


Some rooms will remain closed for now.

Upper School- Maths, English, Science, Options

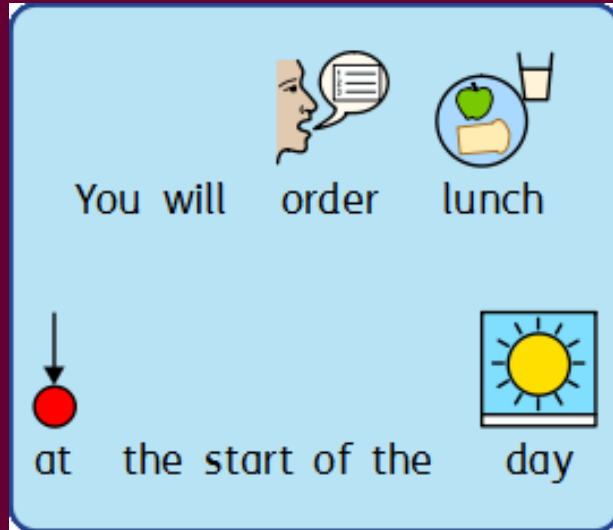
Lower School- PE, Arts Award, Community and Enterprise
