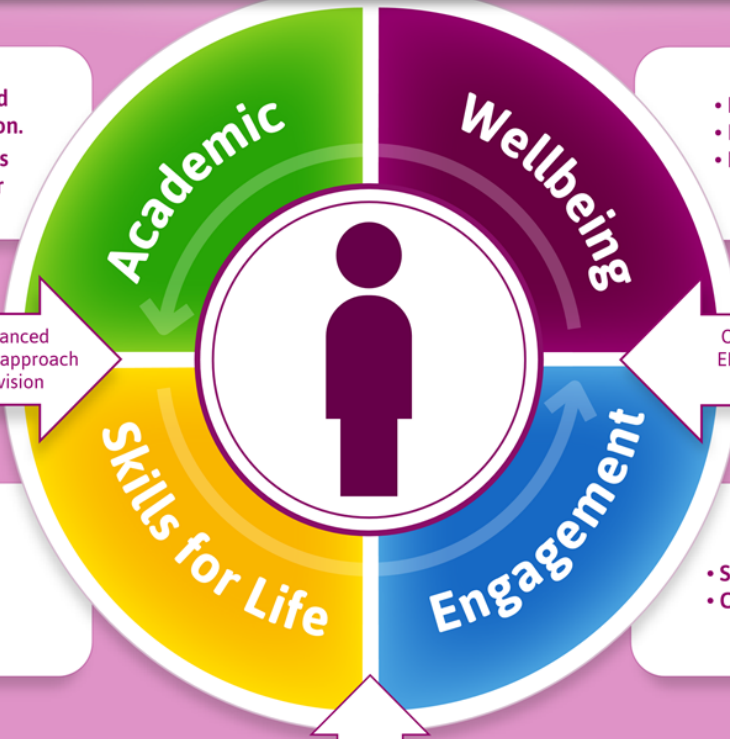


Quest Academy's Ready for Life Framework
