Please see below a reminder of our Quest uniform expectations:

*All learners are expected to wear the following as published in the parents/carers guide to Quest:*

- Black Blazer with Purple Tape on the collar and lapels
- Black V-neck sweatshirt/knitted with purple stripe (either or is acceptable)
- Purple polo shirt with embroidered Quest Academy logo
- Black trousers / Black pleated skirt / soft black trousers for those with sensory issues
- Plain Black shoes or plain black trainers

*The following are the PE Uniform expectations:*

- Black T-Shirt with purple side panels and white piping with embroidered logo
- Black shorts / skirt with purple panels with white piping and logo
- Comfortable sports shoes, pumps or trainers
- Black jogging bottoms with Quest embroidered logo for outdoors when cold

*The following are NOT expected to be adopted by learners:*

- Hats are not to be worn on the school site other than through an agreed sensory need.
- Jewellery should not be worn in school due to the loss / damage which can lead to upset and anxieties.
- Visible piercings are to be stud earrings only.
- Make-up is not encouraged to be worn in school and wipes will be offered where it is felt that any applied is excessive.
- Nail varnish is not encouraged and where it is applied, it should be clear or neutral
