Dear Parents/Carers,

Firstly, I would just like to thank you for your support during this time. I would also like to apologise for any confusion caused linked to our emergency contingency plan.

I would like to reiterate that we will only put our contingency plan into place as a last resort and as staffing levels fluctuate from one day to the next we will assess the situation daily.

The grid below (which has been amended today) has been created to try and give you prior notice of when your child may need to engage in learning from home.

Unless you are contacted, which we will attempt to do before 5pm, your child should be attending school every day as per normal.

Dependent on a particular classes' level of absence there may also be occasions where all of the learners in a class will be asked to engage in learning from home.

I am still hoping that the half term break will provide a "firebreak" so that we do not need to put our contingency plan into place once we return to school after the half term.
