Quest Home Learning Contingency plans September 2021

Learner has to self-isolate at home

Class and teacher have to self-isolate at home



Day 1- Form tutor contact HLL who will provide Home Learning Menu for learner to email home.

Day 2 Onwards-

Form tutor will email any suitable teaching materials from the school day such as Powerpoints/worksheets etc each day to supplement Home Learning Menu

Monitoring and feedback- Form tutor will encourage parents/carers to complete Home Learning Daily Log (link to be emailed home)

Ask parents if they need any additional resources.

Day 1- Form tutor contact HLL who will provide Home Learning Menu for learners to email home.

Day 1- Class teacher will record daily English and Maths lesson plus 1 other curriculum lesson using either Microsoft Teams or Video Record on PowerPoint ready for the next day.

Lessons to be emailed to Office to upload to class Home Learning page on the website. (This could be link to where they are found on the system)

Day 2 Onwards- Teacher to record daily lessons and email ready for the next day.

Monitoring and feedback- Form tutor will encourage parents/carers to complete Home Learning Daily Log (link to be emailed home)

Ask parents if they need any additional resources.

Teacher has to self-isolate at home

If a teacher is self-isolating and working from home then they will teach their lesson from home via Teams with the class team in school setting up the call in the classroom

If a teacher is self-isolating and unwell then they will send cover work in to school by 8.30am on the day of their illness to be delivered by cover staff

Home Learning Monitoring Cycle



Form Tutors make weekly phone call to parents and complete Home Learning Tracker

HLL to forward Home Learning Daily Log to Quest Office to send out 'Well done' email to learners who have completed this. HLL monitor tracker on a weekly basis and ask Tutors to make follow up calls to offer further support to learners who are not engaging.

HLL to monitor Home Learning Daily Log and email Tutors with any issues arising.

Tutors encourage parents to send in work for feedback. Teachers provide feedback via email for work received.

Options Qualifications

If a class that is taught a qualification is selfisolating and the teacher is still in school then a live Zoom lesson will be completed with the teacher of the class setting up the call in school at the time when the lesson would have taken place

If a teacher of a qualification is self-isolating and working from home then they will teach their lesson from home via Teams with the class team in school setting up the call in the classroom.

PSHE/Assemblies

JH to provide 1 PSHE lesson per week, including special days for classes not in school and email to Office to upload to class Home Learning page on website.

JH to ensure that weekly assembly rota is followed and staff send PowerPoint of assembly to Office to upload to class Home Learning page on website.

Form tutors to arrange class Zoom 'catch up' calls once a week to enable learners to stay connected

Safeguarding and Wellbeing



Safeguarding Team to continue to risk assess learners not in school and prioritise home visits as required.

Family Footings to make contact once a week to learners identified in risk assessments

Form tutors to call home at least once a week to perform wellbeing calls to parents. Record conversations in Iris.

Ask to speak to learners during calls.

Safeguarding Team to continue to support families and learners through the newsletter/website.

Highlight e-safety, wellbeing activities, "Talk it out" email and help and support lines.
